- 4. **Available for questions from PSU**. We will make ourselves available for any implementation related questions from the PSU research team.

In return for our cooperation and participation, we understand that in collaboration with PCCD and CMSN, we will receive annual aggregate data from program evaluation surveys. These data will reflect all students who received the *Safe Touches* workshop delivered by your agency under this project.
