1. Award Amount

a) I am seeking clarification regarding the maximum award amount for the NIBRS Compliance Efforts program. According to page 5 of the funding announcement, the maximum award amount is \$200,000. However, the table on page 12 of the funding announcement includes maximum award amounts that exceed \$200,000. Could you please confirm the maximum award amount?

Answer: The maximum award amount under this solicitation is \$200,000. Page 12 of the funding announcement (Appendix A) identifies the total allowable amount defined in Act 54 of 2022 under the Local Law Enforcement Support (LLES) Program. The LLES program includes awards made under the FY 2022-23 LLES solicitation as well as the Recruitment Incentives solicitation. If an agency has already received grant awards under those two solicitations and is interested in this funding opportunity, the total of awards may not exceed the total allowable award amount outlined in Act 54 of 2022. (i.e., total of funds received under FY 2022-23 LLES grant award and/or Recruitment Incentives funding opportunity plus requests under this funding opportunity).

2. Initial NIBRS Release

a) Is this a new program or is there a previous recipients list from the previous year that I can have access to?

Answer: This is a new initiative having a targeted focus on improving the reporting of crime statistics by upgrading technology infrastructure to report incident-based crime data to the FBI's NIBRS.
