ABOUT PCCD

- **Mission:** To enhance the quality, coordination, and planning within the criminal and juvenile justice systems, to facilitate the delivery of services to victims of crime, and to increase the safety of our communities.
- **Vision:** To be a state and national leader supporting programs and practices that promote justice for all citizens and communities of Pennsylvania.
- **Statutory Role:** Serves as the justice planning and policymaking agency for the Commonwealth.



WHAT DO WE DO?

PCCD serves as the justice planning and policymaking agency for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

- **Grants** – PCCD administers state and federal funding through grants of all types – mainly for criminal and juvenile justice and related systems, victim services, prevention, and public safety.
- **Technical Assistance** – We provide technical assistance for a variety of programs and initiatives.
- **Data Resources** – Serve as a statistical resource for criminal justice and public safety data (e.g., digital dashboards, PA Youth Survey, etc.)
- **Victims Compensation** – Provide compensation to victims of crime for certain expenses incurred as a result of that crime.
- **Training** – Provide training for Constables, Sheriffs/Deputy Sheriffs, County Probation Officers, and other justice-related stakeholders.

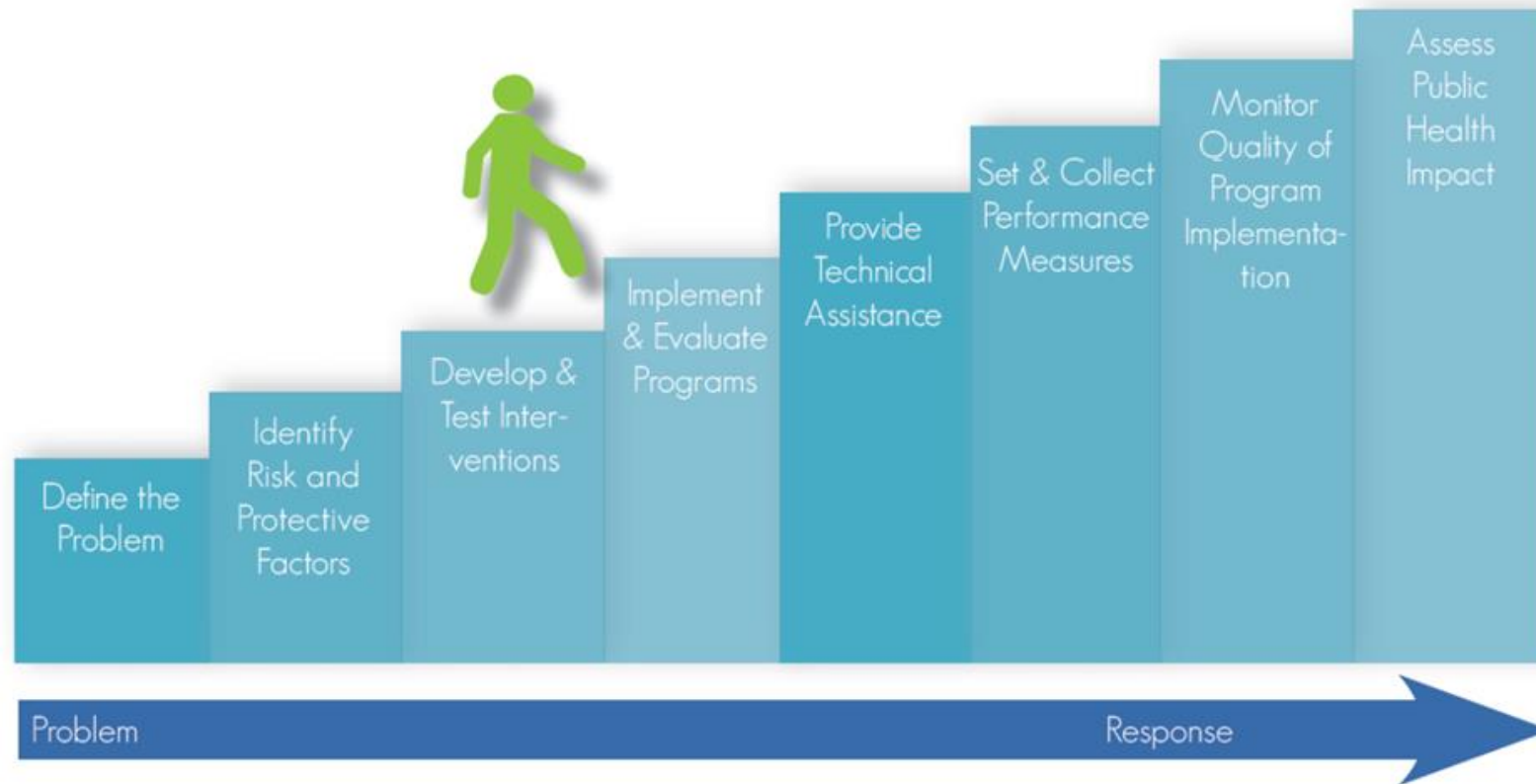

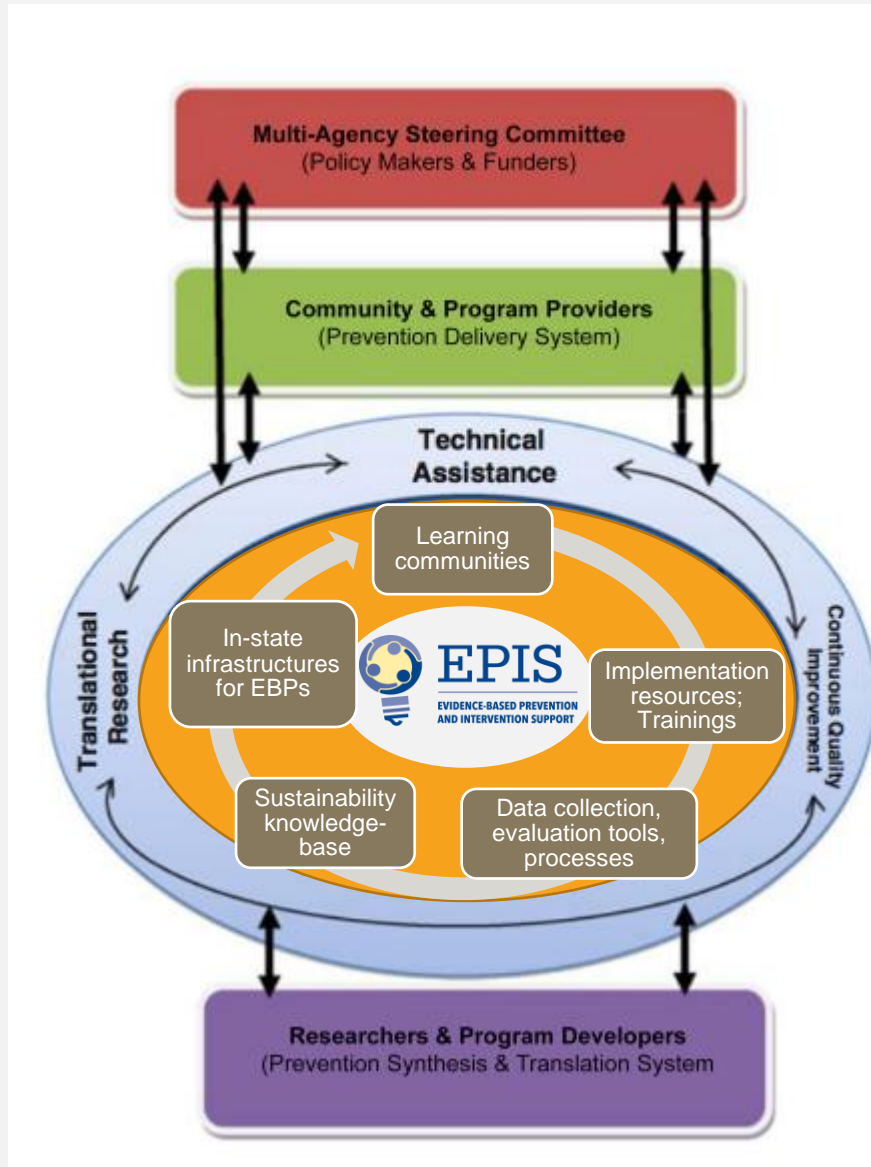

DEFINITIONS FOR SURVEY MONKEY INITIAL REQUEST

Coalition/Community Stakeholder Group:

- Doesn't have to be a fully formed coalition
- Goal is to have the group get to that point

Sponsor Agency: Agency that would be the recipient of the grant, the nonprofit/unit of local government

- Commitments
- Fiscal agent, potentially employ the Coordinator/Director

DEFINITIONS FOR SURVEY MONKEY INITIAL REQUEST CONTINUED

Community: Geographic or impact area

- Could be neighborhood, township, school districts, etc.

Demographics: Statistics around income, poverty level, crime level, ethnicity, gender, race, age, education, employment, etc.

- What is the make up of defined community?

SURVEY MONKEY INITIAL REQUEST

- Link to the Survey Monkey initial request will be provided on PCCCD's website

 - April 23, 2021 to May 24, 2021
- *Be sure to note the Survey Monkey specifics on the next slide
- Recommend downloading the PDF of application questions, prepare, then submit

SURVEY MONKEY TIPS

- Make sure pop-up blocker is off
- Must hit “Next” to next section for your information to be saved from the previous screen
- Not required in one sitting BUT must use same browser and computer/system*
- You can make the text boxes bigger as you are working through the survey
- There are file limits for the attachments – 16MB
- Once you hit “Submit”, you will not be able to edit your request
- There is no opportunity to review the application before submitting it
- You will not receive a confirmation email
