Guidelines and Technology Standards for the Collection and Transmission of Booking Center Captured Offenders' Identification Information

The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) and its partners have developed a set of guidelines and technology standards to facilitate achieving the goals of Act 81 of 2008, and the Federal Walsh Act requirements [as published: 39 Pa.B. 1776 - Saturday, April 4, 2009]. The specifications for all Live Scan equipment have been updated. Additional equipment capable of scanning, capturing, and electronically transmitting fingerprints and palms, in the current NIST/FBI standard format, to the state Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS), located within the Pennsylvania State Police has been identified.

In accordance with the Live Scan Device Performance Specification, the following new devices were tested and approved by the State Law Enforcement Agency, and reviewed and approved by the PCCD Local Technology Workgroup. These devices also appear on the Integrated Automated Fingerprint Identification System (IAFIS) Certified Products List, and are in compliance with the FBI Next Generation Identification initiatives, and IAFIS Image Quality Specifications.
