- Case Initiation
  - MDJ System
    - CCE message is triggered when a case in created
  - CP System
    - CCE message is triggered when a case is brought up to the Common Pleas Court



- Criminal Case Calendar
  - MDJ and CP Systems
    - CCE message is triggered when a calendar event is:
      - Scheduled
      - Continued
      - Cancelled



- Sentencing/Disposition
  - MDJ and CP Systems
    - CCE message is triggered when a sentence or disposition is entered for an offense



- Lifecycle
  - MDJ System
    - CCE message is triggered when a case is:
      - Expunged
      - Limited Access Applied
      - Administratively Closed
      - Transferred to Another Court



- Lifecycle
  - CP System
    - CCE message is triggered when a case is:
      - Expunged
      - Limited Access Applied
      - Administratively Closed
      - Transferred to Another Court
      - Participant Updates

### Court Case Event – Request/Reply

 Provides a service for an agency to request case information from the AOPC

#### Request Criteria

- Docket Number Search
- Offense Tracking Number Search
- Originating Document Number Search
  - Incident
  - Citation
  - Complaint



## Message Format



Extensible Markup Language (XML) is a markup language that defines a set of rules for encoding documents in a format which is both human-readable and machine-readable. It is defined by the W3C's XML 1.0 Specification and by several other related specifications, all of which are free open standards.



#### **AOPC**

- XML stands for eXtensible Markup Language
- Designed to transport and store data
- Content is created and marked up with delimiting tags, making each word, phrase, or chunk into identifiable, sortable information.
- The files consist of elements (tags) and content, and the elements help the documents to be understood when processed electronically or even read from printouts
