FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

At the October 5, 2018 meeting, the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Education and Training Board (SDSETB) suspended all optional instructor training courses, except the Firearms Instructor Re-certification course and the Patrol Rifle Re-certification course. The SDSETB is committed to providing the necessary training for current Board-certified instructors to maintain their certifications.

Due to funding issues, only one re-certification class will be conducted for each course, per year. Recertification is only required every three years. You must be a currently certified instructor to attend re-certification.

Firearms Instructor Re-certification course: July 15th and 16th, 2019 in State College.

Duty sidearm required.
Shotgun provided.

The Patrol Rifle Instructor Re-certification course: July 17th and 18th, 2019 in State College.

Agency patrol rifle required.
Duty side arm required.

Registration is completed electronically, using the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Information System (SDSIS).

As in the past, there is no training registration fees or attendance costs. Also, lodging and meals will be provided.

The SDSETB will no longer provide for the reimbursement of travel costs and salary.

Attendees are now required to supply their own ammunition.



All ammunition must be “new,” factory-manufactured ammunition. Re-loaded ammunition will not be permitted.

Firearms Instructor Re-certification ammunition requirements:

- 300 rounds of handgun ammunition
- 20 rounds of 1oz. shotgun slugs
- 25 rounds of .00 buckshot – 9 pellet shotgun ammunition.

Patrol Rifle Re-certification ammunition requirements:

- 300 rounds of rifle ammunition
- 200 rounds of handgun ammunition.
